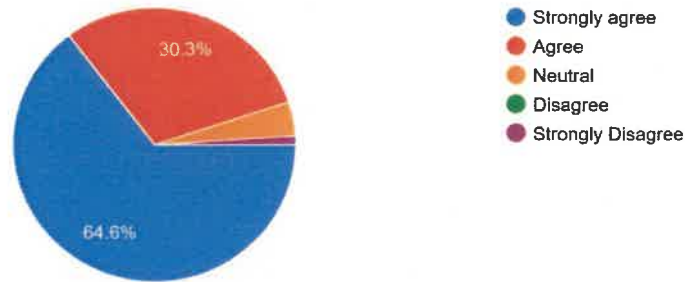

Students Feedback Report on Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness

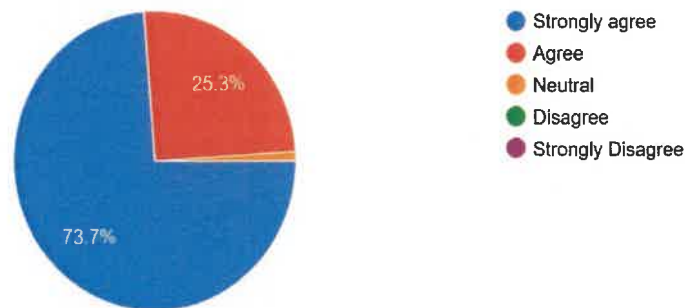

Students Feedback Report on Teaching Practice

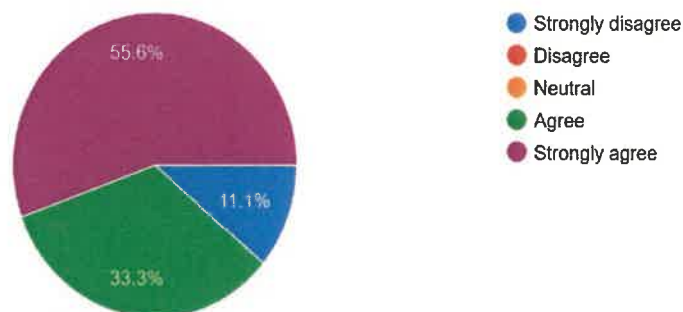

Teachers Feedback on Curriculum

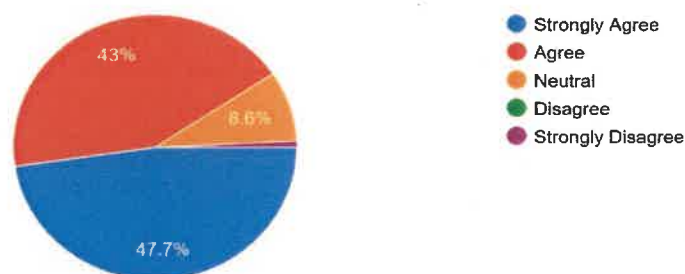

Alumni Feedback Report on for Design and Review of Syllabus

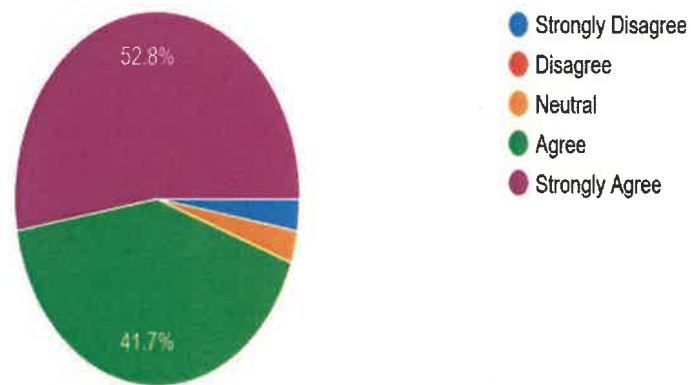
Most of the students agreed that B.Ed. programme create interest to pursue post-graduation/Research in the particular topic and Current Syllabus adequately covers contemporary topics/ global issues/emerging global and national trends.
