

It raises awareness about the condition of human trafficking victims, as well as to promote and safeguard their rights.




This gave us a deep understanding of the procedures followed in eye donation and also it helped us to gain knowledge about the steps that have to be properly followed for a successful eye donation.

Our Rev. Sr. Pauline Mary then donated a saree and food to the elderly women. The program concluded with a vote of thanks.




