1. Stella Matutina College of Education (SMCE) under the Management of the Franciscan Sisters of the Presentation of Our Lady was established in July 1961. The College offers B.Ed., M.Ed., M. Phil. and Ph.D. Degree courses. The College has been

conferred Autonomous status in 2005. However, it continues to be an affiliated College of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and is autonomous in the sense that it is free to frame its own courses of study and to adopt innovative methods of teaching and evaluation. The college has been accredited at the five-star level by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in April 2000, re-accredited at the Grade 'A' level in 2007, and re-accredited (First Cycle) at 'A' Grade with a CGPA: of 3.48 in December 2014. 2. Discretion:


This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is subject to the following:



Stella Matutina College of Education (Autonomous), Ashok Nagar, Chennai – 600083, The First Party represented herein by its Secretary (herein after referred as First Party).

AND

Shalom Academy for Excellence, Ayanavaram, Chennai 600023, The Second Party, and represented herein by its Secretary Ms. A. Thelma Rani (herein after referred as Second Party).

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed at Chennai on 16/9/2021 through the chief functionaries of the parties.

Whereas

- I. The First Party is a College of Education under the Management of the Franciscan sisters of the Presentation of our Lady was established in July 1961. The College offers B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D degree Programmes in Education. The College has been offered autonomous status in 2005. However, it continues to be an affiliated college of Tamilnadu Teacher Education University. Under the autonomous status, the college deserves the right to establish and exhibit essential study courses, educational transaction strategies, and evaluation as per the timely needs, of its own, and under the guidelines of the UGC norms in the realm of Teacher Education. The college has been accredited at FIVE STAR level by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in April 2000, and re-accredited at Grade 'A' level in 2007, and further re-accreditation for the third cycle at 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.48 in December 2014. NCTE rendered due recognition to the college by granting permission to admit 200 students as annual intake for B-Ed programme, 50 students as annual intake for M.Ed programme from the academic year 2015-2016. With the motto "Attain Truth by the path of love", the College strives hard to instill in Teacher Trainees, the love of mankind and the love for truth finding. Besides the teacher education curriculum, the students are equipped with Citizenship training, social awareness and societal sensitivity, educational technology, and moral and ethical values through Conferences, Seminars, Workshops, and Online programmes. Thus, the students not only get graduated to earn a profession, but also get honed to change the society at large.
- II. And the Second Party is an institution under the Shalom Trust (607/2013). It is aimed to enhance the academic performance, and enrich the inner potentials of the students with varied skills training and entrepreneurship training programmes. The Academy also provides welfare programmes for women. The Academy also proposes to provide Preprimary programmes also in the rural sectors. It is a young institution with enormous resourcefulness. Having started in 2019, the Academy could train a set of 86 students belonging to Higher Secondary and Undergraduate students in their academic subjects and communication skills acquisition. During Covid19 lockdown, counseling for women welfare and health care programmes to boost immunity through proper diet system were advocated through online programme using zoom app. Also, during Covid19 lockdown, the Academy conducted an online debate in collaboration with Singapore Tamil Sangam for the welfare of the students and teachers on Teachers' Day, 5th September, 2020. In addition, the Academy representatives took part in Panel discussion, EduLead 2020, and organized an International online conference for 5 days on cognitive skills, joining Stella Matutina College of Education, for the benefits of the Teaching-learning communities. On 5/5/2021, a bulletin of Teacher's Day wishes with information on You tube was organized and aired.

The objective of the Academy is to help students identify their untapped resourcefulness to gain overall development for their future uplift.

(First Party and Second Party are herein after jointly referred as 'Parties', and individually as 'Party')

Now therefore in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MoU, the parties here to agree as follows

1. Purpose and Objectives

- 1.1 to make a bridge between the Teacher Education Institution, the First Party and the Society by means of Social awareness programmes.
- 1.2 To help student teachers realize their potentials, tap and develop their hidden talents through appropriate schemes to gain the skills as per timely demands.
- 1.3 To help the teacher trainees adapt and accommodate themselves according to the needs of the emerging society
- 1.4 To imbibe thinking skills in the student teachers and thereby help them formulate a thinking society as they serve in the community
- 1.5 To help student teachers have self realization and self actualization radiating love for mankind.
- 1.6 To help the Teacher Educators be equipped with all the resources to make their wards become meaningful citizens competent with global standards.

2. Scope of the MoU

The parties having well understood the objectives of the collaboration, have meticulously framed programmes to establish the objectives. The Second Party will provide needed techniques and trainings to enhance the resources (Teacher Trainees and Trainers) of the First Party as per the following.

- 2.1 Apart from the programmes prescribed by UGC for B.Ed and M.Ed programmes, Awareness programmes for communal harmony will be conducted periodically.
For example. How young girls can protect themselves (safety measures with digital technology employed by Government Security Sectors, Mental stamina through Human welfare counselors).
- 2.2 At least 2 seminars/workshops per year for identification and development of the potential capacities of the student teachers and appreciate self realization.
- 2.3 Skill Based Training to the individual student teachers.
For example.
 - a. How to prepare lessons for online teaching.
 - b. Skills to become an Academic Toastmaster
 - c. Communication skills for effectiveness

2.4 Students' initiative programmes for developing thinking skills

For example,

- a. Think without ink
- b. TAT test items for individual students

2.5 Placement of Trained Students.

2.6 Programmes for resourcefulness.

Learning is never ending and ever growing. As Teacher Educators is very much a learning community, it is the responsibilities of the institution to expose them to the skills domain to help them acquire and attain competencies in the areas of their interest for teaching and learning.

The Teacher Educators will be provided with Seminar/Workshops on

- a. Research and development in Teacher Education
- b. Online teaching techniques etc.

The members of the in-service Teacher Educators can be provided with new knowledge learning skills.

For example,

- a. Journal writing and finding reputed journals for publication.
- b. Proposal writing and finding financial sources etc.

3. Intellectual Property

Nothing contained in the MoU shall, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs, of the other Party.

4. Validity

The parties recognize the mutual benefits derived from their collaborative efforts for the enrichment of their wards. Hence the parties concur with the following understanding of agreement.

- a. The MoU is realised from the academic year 2021-2022 till 2023 - 2024 for a period of Three consecutive academic years. The agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutual agreement. Any act on the part of the Second Party after termination of the agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be constructed as an extension of this MoU.
- b. Both parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination both the parties agree to discharge their obligations.

5. Relationship between the Parties

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be considered as partnership. Neither party is authorized to use the other party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligations or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other party, without the prior written consent of the Party. Neither party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU.
